- ✿ Be from a family that is actively involved in beef production and currently a member of IBA.
- ✿ Agriculture Major.
- ✿ Possess Communication, Computer & Social Media skills.
- ✿ Complete the application and include a copy of your resume.
- ✿ Include a copy of your current school transcript.
- ✿ Prepare a cover sheet with your:

 - √ **Complete school mailing address and phone number**
 - √ **Name of the college you are attending**
 - √ **Future plans**
 - √ **Permanent mailing address and phone number**
